

## THE GILLY FUND AT WORK

Over the last 4 years there was a project in Nanaimo to create a bypass channel on the Millstone River to allow Salmon to get around the falls that were blocking access to the upper river and to Brannen Lake.

The City of Nanaimo, the Pacific Salmon Foundation, the Dept. of Fisheries and Oceans, the Nanaimo Fish and Game along with the Island Waters Fly Fishers all contributed funds or in kind labour etc. to see this project to finish.

It came to pass that some funds were required to construct a suitable building to house the electrical panel and sundries for the fish counter and the cameras that would monitor the movement of the fish up the channel.

A request for funds was submitted to the BCFFF Gilly fund for \$6000.00 to fund the building. This was approved and the building went ahead and now sits with proper signage crediting the BCFFF and the Gilly Fund.
